The address of trainings:

Veresegyhaz, Fabriczius Jozsef Altalanos Iskola, Mogyorodi ut 5-7.
This is a basketball hall, (540 squeremeter) .

Location:

From Budapest by car M3 highway to the EXIT Gödöllő (26 km stone) and turn left to Veresegyhaz.

Veresegyhaz is a small town to the North-East from Budapest (30 kilometer). In the town you can find a SPA (front of the training hall), swimming pool and a bear and wolf farm, some good restaurants and pubs. The public transport from Budapest and back is really good and simple by train. I prefer for everybody stay in Budapest and travel to the place of the training everyday, because the capital is more interesting and really nice. The railway station is in downtown of Budapest and the training hall is about 10 minutes by walk from the Veresegyhaz train stop. I cannot booking any hotel in Budapest because the summer season is very busy, but everybody can find byself the best possibility in the internet (for example: www.hotels.hu).

But if somebody wants to stay in Veresegyhaz please write me and I try to accommodate a few rooms in a pension there.
